SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION: The proposed trust parcels are owned in fee by the Shivwits Band of Paiutes and located within north-central Hurricane, Utah approximately 1.8 miles southeast of Quail Creek State Park in an area referred to locally as Zion's Gate. Parcels H-4-1-36-106 and H-4-1-36-220 make up the project site and are in the southeastern quarter of Section 36, Township 41 South, Range 14 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian and the northeastern quarter of Section 1, Township 42 South, Range 14 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian.
